Dear Grand Chief:

The Cree-Québec Forestry Board is pleased to send you the summary document presenting the main findings and issues identified in the context of the 2008-2013 assessment of the implementation of the forestry-related provisions of the Paix des Braves.

The five-year period in question enabled us to give effect to the Adapted Forestry Regime and implement the vast majority of the Agreement's technical provisions. From the stakeholders' viewpoint, the Adapted Forestry Regime seems to be better understood now, and a more far-reaching commitment within an approach involving continuous improvement is observed. We hope for even greater collaboration between those involved in implementing these provisions and adaptive management (based on the assessment completed and evolution of the Adapted Forestry Regime) and that the economic component will be integrated further yet.

In keeping with its mandate, the Board will continue to work with the stakeholders concerned to monitor the main issues identified.
